IFSHT is establishing a library of educational videos for our members. The videos will be available on this website and hosted through You Tube. We welcome any videos that you are willing to share and have posted on our website and we would like to start with anatomy, evaluation and splinting videos. All videos they must follow the guidelines below.

Guidelines:

- 1. Videos must be in English. You must be fluent in English.
- 2. Information must be appropriate and relevant to our hand therapy audience.
- 3. Information must be relevant in today's environment.
- 4. Video creator/author must sign a non-disclosure agreement.
- 5. The video must include an IFSHT disclaimer that will be provided to them once the video is approved and the non-disclosure agreement is signed. This disclaimer must be included at the beginning of the video.
- 6. You cannot promote yourself, your personal business or a commercial organization that you have any financial ties to. You, however, can talk about materials and products that you may use.
- 7. The audio on the presentation must be easy to hear and not have any background noise or distractions. Voice overs can be used.
- 8. Speaker to include information on how this is relevant to their hand therapy practice and what type of practice they have.
- 9. Video must be considerate of the world at large and reach a global audience e.g., some countries do not have thermoplastics so discuss the position of the hand versus the type of material being used.

The videos will be reviewed by our Education committee before being posted to make sure they meet the guidelines noted above.
